Alpine Ibex (Capra ibex) Hunting

The Alpine Mountains of Austria & Slovenia

Date(s): Hunting 1st August to 31st December; Best Time (Rut): end-November to mid-December.

Ibex / Hunters / Days: No. of days & Alpine Ibex per rifle (stalker / hunter) - to be confirmed.

Itinerary Price: Pricing depends on location and accommodation.

Management Species: Alpine Ibex (Capra ibex) also known as the steinbock or bouquetin, are instantly

recognisable in the European Alps, displaying extreme sexual dimorphism and

horn length - the females are significantly smaller.

Insurance:

European shooting / hunting liability insurance is required.

Firearms:

Rifles & Ammunition

Rifles & ammunition maybe borrowed or imported for hunting Alpine Ibex. There is a good selection of quality scoped game rifles that maybe borrowed. If guests wish to bring their own rifles, we can organise 'Firearms Import Permits' and advise on specific country import limits on rifles and ammunition. We recommended that a rifle calibre of no less than 7mm with a bullet of 160+ grains; .270 or the .30 calibres for Alpine Ibex is preferred, fitted with a good 'mountain range' hunting riflescope.

N.B. We will advise on the legal use of sound moderators per hunting country.

Accommodation:

Accommodation is based on the number of hunters & guests for stated nights.
 (i.e. from the night before the first hunting day to and including the night of the last hunting day), breakfast and lunch is included in the total lbex hunting price. The hotel / hunting lodge depends on hunting country and location.

Travel Details: The arrival date will be the day before the first hunting day and the departure

date will be the day after the last hunting day. All hunting trips start and finish at the stated airport, which we will advise on, depending on the hunting location.

Booking Terms: Booking will be confirmed upon receipt of a 25%, conditional deposit.* The

remaining 75% balance is due no later than sixty (60) days prior to the first hunting date. The primary named guest is responsible for all and total payment.



GAME FEE DEPOSIT

A game fee deposit is required from each hunter. This deposit is held by the company in a 'Designated Client Account' (* regulated by Financial Conduct Authority) for game fees plus any additional extras, such as gratuities, further firearms hire, taxidermy fees & export, extra excursions, special requests etc. Any game fees and/or additional extras are put against this amount and reconciled at the end of your hunting trip. Once your hunting trip extras have been calculated and agreed, any over payment will be refunded or additional funds will be requested.
